Establish and maintain an overall UNK grade point average of 2.75 or higher. 3. Successfully complete (minimum scores are mandated by the Nebraska Department of Education) all three components of the PRAXIS I Skills Test (Reading, Writing, and Mathematics). 4. Satisfactorily complete the Service Learning Project (verified by the Office for Service Learning). 5. Obtain approval by the department(s) offering the proposed endorsement(s) (A minimum of one field endorsement or one subject endorsement is required.) 6. Declare a teaching program(s) at the Academic and Career Services Office. 7. Provide evidence of the absence of any criminal conviction (misdemeanor or felony) that would prevent a student from qualifying for a teaching certificate. 8. Provide evidence of sufficient emotional and mental capacity.
