You can go to the Application page to do this. • Complete the American College Test (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and request that the official results be sent to Chadron State College. Our ACT college code is 2466. Our SAT college code is 6466. • Request that a final, official high school transcript with your graduation date, final GPA and final class rank be sent directly from your high school to the Chadron State College Admissions Office. If applicable, Home School transcripts or official GED certification should be submitted. Nebraska GED scores can be ordered by calling 402-471-2475 or ordered online at: www.education.ne.gov/. Out-of-state GED scores can be ordered by contacting the Department of Education for the state in which the test was taken. If the student graduated from high school or earned a GED within the past five years, the ACT is required. If the student graduated from high school or earned a GED over six years ago, an eCompass test is required. • NOTE: If you have taken college courses, request a final, official transcript be sent to the CSC Admissions office.
