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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four years of mathematics that include Algebra I, II, geometry, and one year that builds on a knowledge of algebra. • Three years of natural sciences that include at least two years selected from biology, physics, chemistry, and earth science and one year of laboratory instruction. • Three years of social studies that include at least one year of American and/or world history and one year of history, American government, and/or geography.
